WHAT TO WEAR

TOILETRIES

- Deodorant
- Sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher) & bug spray
- Personal care supplies as needed (briefs, swim briefs, wipes, chucks pads, etc.)



ESSENTIALS:

- Bedding: twin sheets, blanket (or sleeping bag), and pillow- beds will be made daily so whatever sets you up for success!
- Beach towel AND shower towel
- Dirty laundry bag
- Reusable water bottle
- Bible, notebook, and pen
- Flashlight, backpack, rain poncho
- Chargers for adaptive devices
- Re-Packing List for staff and buddies to check!



BRING TO CHECK-IN:
